*These items ideally should be housed in museums due to their importance and rarity!*

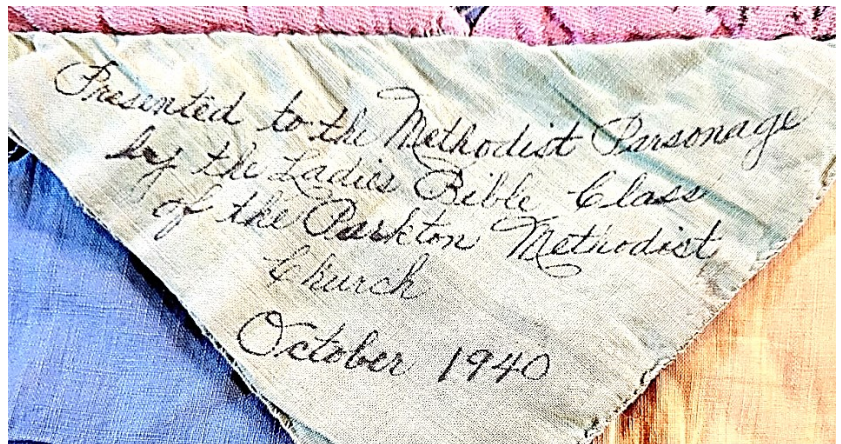

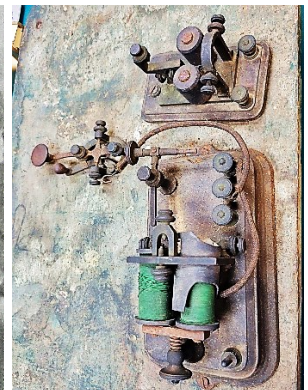
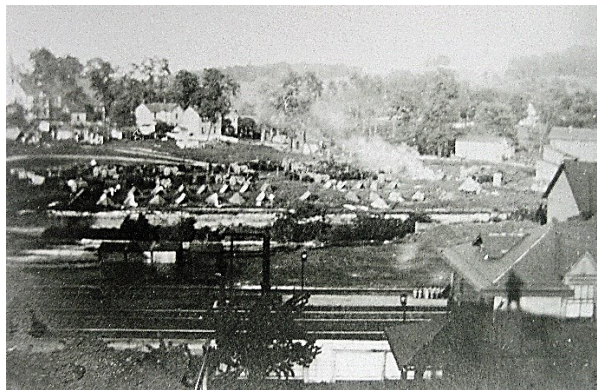
*Parkton Train Station, south side, circa 1945*
